



In California, Baltazar "Bong" Fedalizo is running for congressional district 37, consists of South-Central Los Angeles, Inglewood, Marina and Playa Del Rey's and Culver City a suburb of Los Angeles.

He is not enrolled but says he is Chiricahua Apache on his mother's side. The father is Filipino both are veterans. He is running on a platform of supply chain, energy and homelessness. Fedalizo was a Supply Corps Officer in the Navy, a LA Business Journal award winner for manufacturing biodiesel and went bankrupt when biodiesel market collapsed.
